The corporations on our annual list of the world's 500 largest companies combined to generate \$41.7 trillion in revenue in 2024, up 1.8% from the previous year. Together, they employ 70.1 million people, and their revenue represents more than one-third of the world's GDP. The Global 500 earned \$2.98 trillion in profit in its second-most-profitable year ever; \$1 trillion of that was generated by companies in finance. For the 12th consecutive year and the 20th time since 1995, Walmart was No. 1 on the list. This year's top 10 is little changed from last year's—but further down the list, global tech companies made dramatic leaps, among them social media giant Meta Platforms (up 25 spots, to No. 41), AI chipmaker Nvidia (up 156, to No. 66), and Chinese electric-vehicle juggernaut BYD (up 52, to No. 91).

Companies are ranked by total revenues for their respective fiscal years ended on or before March 31, 2025. All companies on the list must publish financial data and report part or all of their figures to a government agency. Figures are as reported, and comparisons are with the prior year's figures as originally reported for that year. *Fortune* does not restate the prior year's figures for changes in accounting.

How is this list different from the Fortune 500? The Fortune Global 500 is our annual ranking of the largest 500 corporations worldwide as measured by total revenue, whereas the Fortune 500 is exclusively U.S. corporations.
